



The Dallas Cowboys' tailba with only one touchdown t year, was knocked out of Sunda game against the San Francis 49ers when he strained his groin in the second quarter.

Smith was retaped in the lock room and sat on the bench wearing a baseball cap, not his h met — for the final few series of first half.

He changed into street cloth during halftime, watching the re of the game from the sideline. appeared to be walking gingerly the sideline.

Smith, who had surgery on l right ankle in January, also w unable to finish Dallas' ga against Arizona on Sept. 7. He that game in the fourth quar [] with bruised ribs on his right sic

Smith, who entered the gas fifth in the NFC with 688 yas rushing, gained 31 yards on sev carries before going out Sunday's game. His last carry v 0 a 5-yard run on the fifth play of t second quarter.

In seven previous seaso including three Super Bowl-w ning campaigns, Smith had 1 touchdowns rushing — an avera of just under one a game.

But his touchdown slump t year is the most visible sign of t Cowboys' overall offensive pro lems. Dallas has been beset offensive line problems, and ft back Daryl Johnston is out follo ing neck surgery

Though Smith has run for me than 100 yards twice this sease the Cowboys lost both gam Before this season, the Cowbe were 47-5 when Smith rushed 100 or more yards in a game.
