

'We go out there and try tow in everything, in academic research and athletics, and wew continue to do that.'

No bones are made about the fact that the football program's sur cess is directly related to the enth siasm of students and the mone given by key financial backers.

"In this part of the count football is important to gettin alums and students excited about their involvement in the university, to getting donations, which are important to the shrinking budgets of schools," Hicks said.

Dodds will chair the search committee and will be joined by Hicks, Royal and three of his former players: Bob Moses 0 Houston, Doug English of Austin and Alfred Jackson of Houston.

The other four members are Texas men's athletics council chairwoman Waneen Spirduso; Mike Myers of Dallas, representing former students; B.M. "Mack" Rankin of Dallas, head of the Longhorn Foundation Advisory Council; and at-large selection Prof. Charles Alan Wright of the UT School of Law.
