Even if the soundtrack catches a snag with Poe and Pop, it is redeemed by "Breakable."

This song by little-known artist Fisher features words that ring as reminders of the repercussions of insensitivity.

With phrases such as "Every time you throw him to the floor, / why are you surprised to see he's breakable," the

song peers into the sorrow of unreturned love.

The message is: while people might be annoyed by an unwanted love, they should recognize the sufferings of their admirers.

As a whole, the soundtrack for *Great Expectations* is impressive and entertaining.

With smart lyrics and talented artists, this compilation departs from the usual soundtrack pitfall of big budget movies, which rely on big names and cheesy Celine Dionish ballads.

The soundtrack features a collection of songs ranging from soulful to sassy, weaving tales of angst, anger and love from afar.

If the soundtrack is a catalyst, *Great Expectations* will be worth the hype.

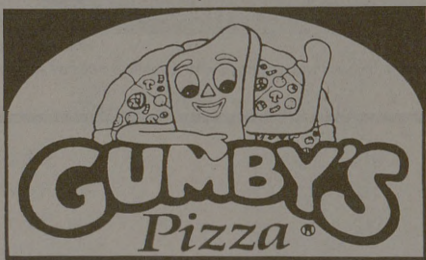

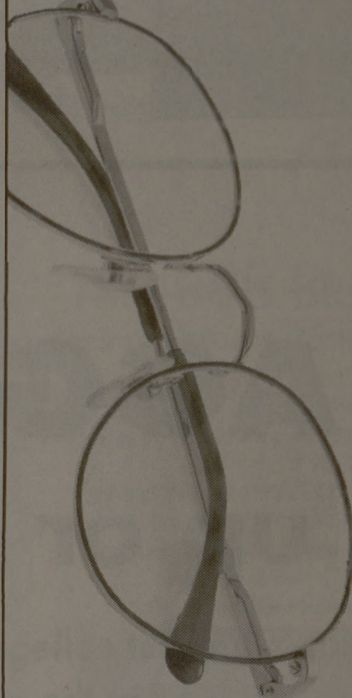

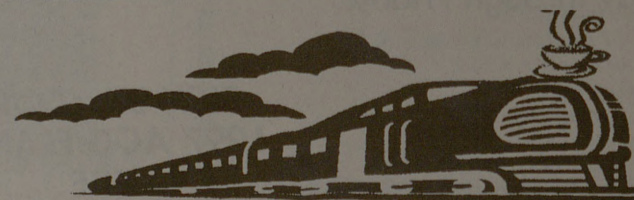
