# AGGIES IN THE SUPER BOWL

Gary Kubiak ♦ Offensive Coordinator/Quarterback Coach ♦ Denver Broncos since 1995

Aggie Ties: Quarterback from 1979-82; Running Backs Coach from 1992-93. Kubiak threw for over 4,000 yards and 31 touchdowns in his career at Texas A&M. He played in one bowl game, the Independence Bowl in 1981. He led the Aggies to a 33-16 victory over Oklahoma State. Kubiak, on 15 of 20 passing, threw for 255 yards and two touchdowns.

His biggest honor at Texas A&M came in 1982 when he was selected by his teammates as the Aggie Heart Award Winner. The award is the most coveted and cherished honor given to an A&M football player each year.

Kubiak started his coaching career back at Texas A&M in 1992. He spent two years with the Aggies as the running backs coach and tutored players such as Greg Hill, Rodney Thomas, Leeland McElroy and Detron Smith.

Detron Smith ♦ Fullback ♦ Denver Broncos since 1996

Aggie Ties: Fullback from 1982-84. Smith was primarily a blocker during his career at Texas A&M. He scored holes for Aggies Greg Hill and Leeland McElroy. Smith did gain 184 other carries and scored one touchdown at A&M. He also caught 33 passes and recorded the highest mark in the school press (430 pounds) in the Herbie season conditioning program during his senior year.

Smith, who attended Lakeview High School in Dallas, was an American as a senior. He carried more than 1,300 yards and scored touchdowns his senior year.

Smith was the 65th overall pick in the 1996 draft before playing in 13 games for the Broncos as a rookie.

Johnny Holland ♦ Defensive Assistant/Quality Control ♦ Green Bay Packers since 1995

Aggie Ties: Linebacker from 1983-86. Holland was one of the original products of "Linebacker University," the name given to A&M for its string of outstanding linebackers to go on to the NFL. "Mr. Anywhere," as he was called during his days as an Aggie, was a two-time All-American. He led the Aggies in tackles twice and recorded over 140 tackles three times. Holland also had two 20-tackle games en route to becoming the Aggies' all-time leading tackler with 455.

Holland was the Green Bay Packers' second round draft pick in 1987 and recorded over 100 tackles for six consecutive seasons. He was forced to retire due to a neck injury after the 1993 season, ending his seven-year career.

Holland was inducted into the Texas A&M Athletic Hall of Fame in 1993, before his retirement from the NFL.

Mike Sherman ♦ Tight Ends/Assistant Offensive Coach ♦ Green Bay Packers since 1997

Aggie Ties: Offensive Linebacker from 1989-93; 1995-96. Sherman served under Billings for seven years and accompanied most of five bowl games in that time. Sherman left A&M to follow coaching coach Bob Toledo to UCLA. He will be the next year to help the Aggies win the Alamo Bowl and a victory over the Sooners. Following the 1996 season, Sherman accepted A&M's offer to become offensive coordinator, but later accepted the Green Bay Packers' offer.

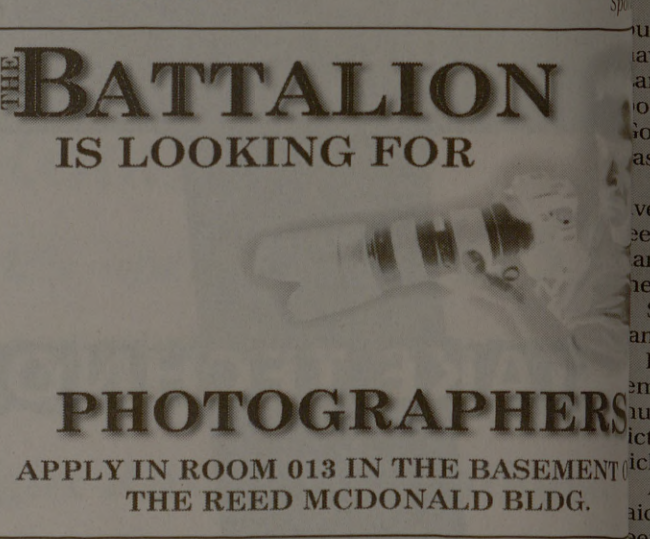
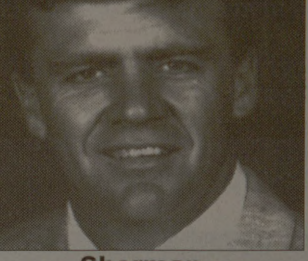
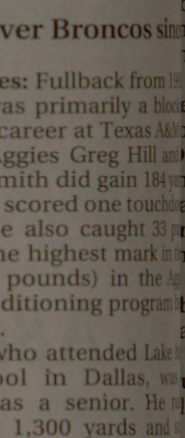
