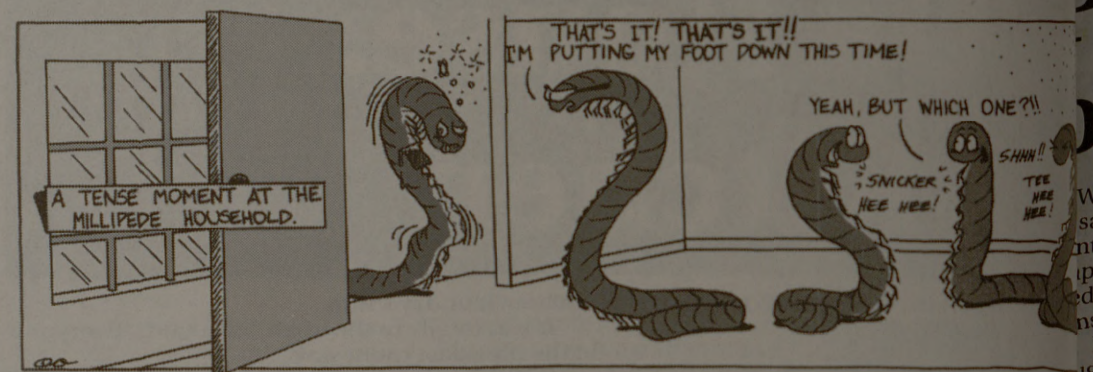

### Cattlemen test second show enough to...

AMARILLO (AP) — A show by Oprah Winfrey on the potential threat of mad cow disease was not enough to ease caused by the first, she testified Monday in the defamation lawsuit.

"She didn't go on the air and eat a hamburger in the world," Bill O'Brien, co-owner of Texas Beef Group and one of several cattlemen who blame Winfrey for plummeting red meat prices following her April 16, 1996, program about "dangerous food."

Winfrey's show came to the March 1996 British government that their decade-long cow outbreak probably similar human disease that about two dozen people.

A guest on her first safety activist Howard Lyman criticized the practice of rendering livestock products into cattle, a practice thought to spread mad cow disease to land, and made illegal last summer.
