In a college town with as many students as A&M has, there is a variety of coffee shops to serve your needs.

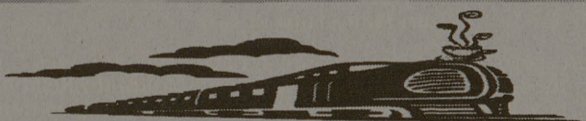

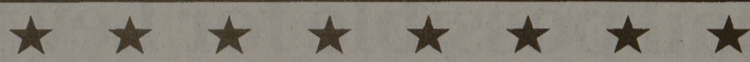
