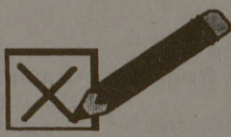

in high school when we needed a good enough score to get accepted.

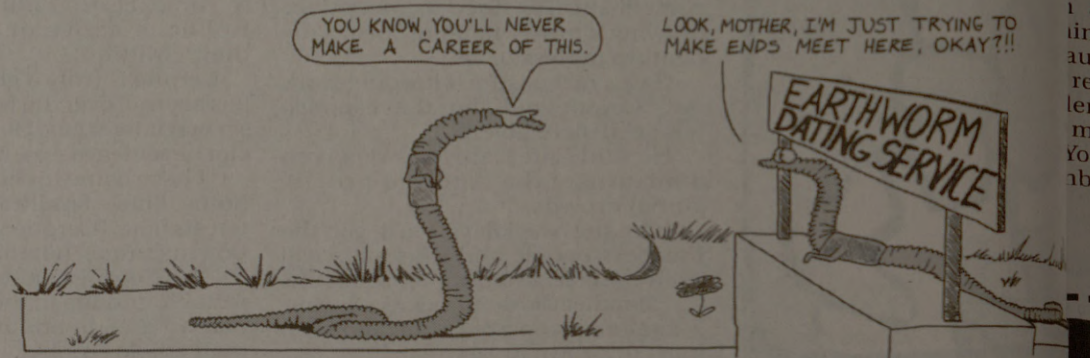
