Swim team sets record at NCAA

Behind a sixth-place finish by the 400-freestyle relay team at the final event, Texas A&M won the 1998 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships Saturday in Auburn, Ala., marking the school's first victory in the event.

The team, which coach David Morrow led, won the 400-freestyle relay by a 3:59.51, followed by the defending champion Auburn and Texas (3:56.25).

Freshman Meghan Jolivet also won the discus with a throw of 157.9 meters. The men's 4x400 relay team placed first with a time of 3:09.51, and the women's 4x100 relay team won with a time of 1:39.51.
