## **Crawford goes on** the road to promote

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Christina Crawford isn't finished yet with her Mommie Dearest.

Twenty years after publishing the tell-all book about being abused by her adoptive mother, actress Joan Crawford, Christina Crawford is hitting the road to promote a 400-page revision.

"I put in eyewitness accounts

that had come to me after the book was published. It's now a complete chronicle of a very turbulent and chaotic, and compelling, and in some instances, loving relationship that covers almost 40 years," she said.

Crawford, 58, begins a series of speaking engagements Wednesday at the Royal Theater in Los Angeles. "April Fool's with Christina Crawford" will also tour Seattle, New York and Chicago.

The evening will include a showing of the 1981 movie *Mommie* Dearest, starring Faye Dunaway, though Christina Crawford has criticized the film as "a piece of fiction." The new book, which Crawford

published by herself, is available through the Internet.

Joan Crawford, who starred in such movies as *Mildred Pierce*, Whatever Happened to Baby Jane? and Autumn Leaves, died in 1970.
