Teen heartthrobs to tour in summer

LOS ANGELES (AP) — The '70s swoon squad of Bobby Sherman, Davy Jones and Peter Noone will tour this summer.

The "Teen Idols Tour" will kick off June 12 in Reno, Nev., with stops around the country through early September, publicist Lori Lousararian said Monday.

Sherman, whose hits include "Hey Little Woman" and "Cried Like a Baby," said the '70s are back.

"I didn't want to go on tour unless I felt it was right," he said. "Over the last three or four years there's been a '70s resurgence, so I think mainly what makes this work is the timing."

As the frontman for Herman's Hermits, Noone became a star with "There's A Kind Of Hush" and "Mrs. Brown You've Got A Lovely Daughter."

Jones sang such Monkees hits as "Daydream Believer."

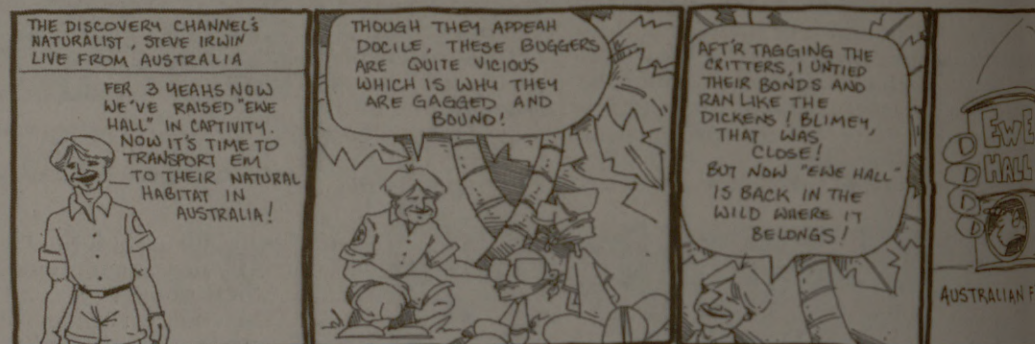

The title track to Randy Travis' new album, *You and You Alone*, takes the doldrums of songwriting to a level that has been reached time and again. And although there is nothing new to the lyrics, Travis' voice carries the words in such a loving way listeners cannot help but keep an intent ear to the speaker.

Travis sings, "Only you and you alone / Can turn the darkest night into dawn / The only reason for hangin' on / Is you and you alone."

For those who are country music fans, this new album of-

fers the classic sound of country music, not the new hip and poppy sounds of singers such as Shania Twain and the like.

One particular track that might catch people's attention is "Spirit of a Boy, Wisdom of a Man." On this selection, Travis tells the story of a two 16-year-olds who fall in love; the girl is going to bear a child for the young man.

Travis sings, "Hearts caught fire, and love ran wild / She cried the day she called to say / She was having his child / With so much riding on the choice of a boy, or the wisdom of a man."

The social awakening aspect of Travis' music is what draws

listeners in; it's the lyrics that make this album worth listening to. Travis' voice, on the other hand, carries with it the country twang it usually has, but that is not such a harsh critique; most people have come to know and love his slow and steady motion vocals deliver.

On "Horse Called Music" however, Travis tends to draw his draw out a bit too much and the song suffers for it.

Overall, *You and You Alone* is a collection of songs about the road, love and the way it comes about from life situations. The end result is an album that people should listen to when their mind begins to wander.
