Warden estimates high illiteracy rate

DALLAS (AP) — The illiteracy rate in the Texas prison system, estimates Elvis Hightower, senior warden at Hutchins State Jail, "has to be at least 85 to 90 percent."

"Without some serious (educational) help while they're here, they're going to come right back to us," Hightower said. To that end, language therapist Lucy Smith of Hurst began a program last fall called the HOPE project — Helping Others Pursue Education. It's now a part of the Hutchins State Jail south of Dallas and the Gatesville Trustee Camp.

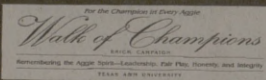
