Estill said his group is also building two grass football practice fields in place of the tennis center, set for completion in June.

A new tennis center will also be completed this summer.

Three other projects within the construction division are the Texas Transportation Institute in Research Park, the new dairy products building on Discovery Drive and the expansion of the Corps Repository in

the Ocean Drilling Building on Discovery Drive.

Tom Williams, Director of Parking, Traffic and Transportation Services (PTTS), said the library construction in the center of campus is the major university project for the summer.

"We will be occupying the new garage by next fall," Williams said. "We will also be doing the normal parking lot renovations, like painting new lines, to get ready for next year."

Along with the additional parking garage, Williams said this year brought 1,500 new parking spots with the opening of Reed Arena. The

University will begin a project to expand the Zachry parking lot to 600 new spaces. The project has been put on hold until the soccer field is relocated on West campus.

Several road construction projects are set for the future, including Ross Street, which runs in front of the Chemistry Building. Ross has been closed because of a construction project done in 1990.

University officials said they are waiting to finish the street work for a new chemical engineering building on Ross Street are finished.

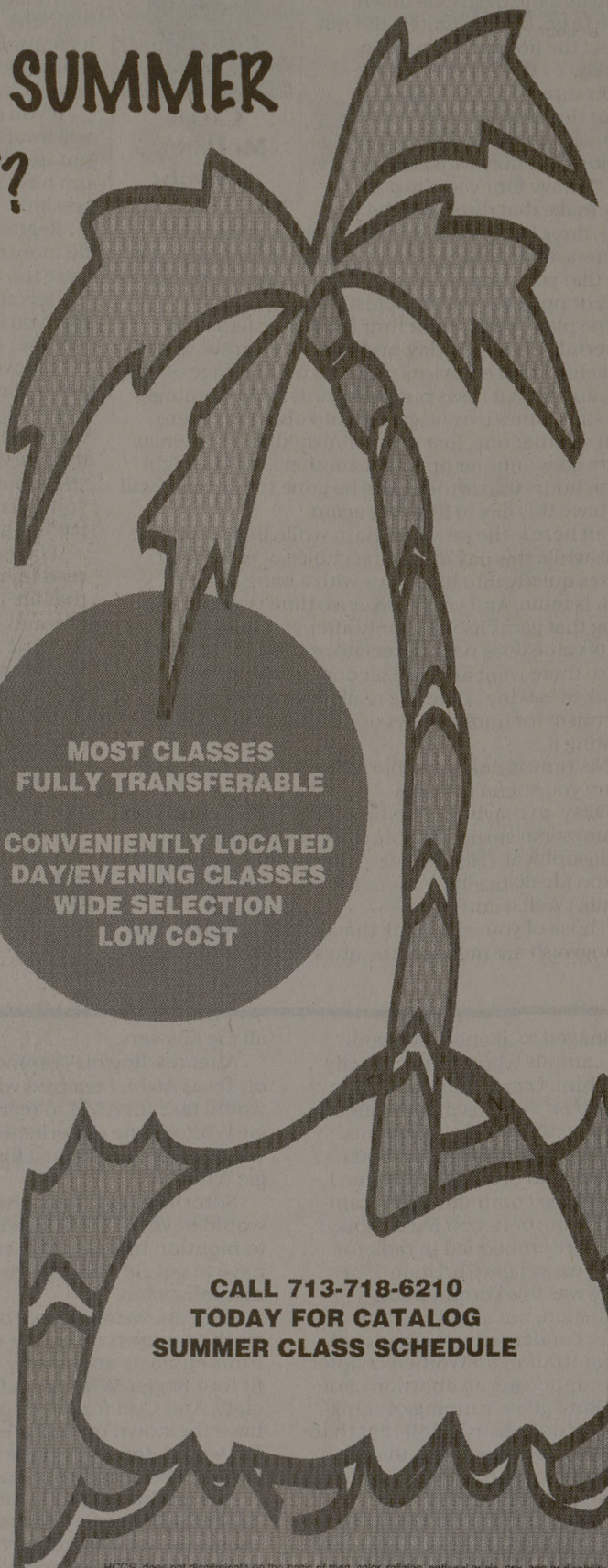
