

Ashlock said the final number of minority students will depend on


the number of summer conference attendees who enroll, how many summer provisional students will succeed and how many scholar-


ship athletes will be admitted. 'These and other numerous changes from last year make it impractical to predict at this time what our minority student picture will be in September," said Ashlock.





