New Releases Movie Roundup

The Truman Show
 Starring Jim Carrey and Ed Harris
 Playing at Post Oak Cinema and Schulman Six

Jim Carrey stars in a thoughtful, poignant, film with nary a fart joke to be found. No it isn't Hollywood in bizarro world. It is *The Truman Show*, probably one of the better films this year. Carrey plays Truman Burbank, a man whose life is one big television show. Truman is unaware the trials and tribulations of his life are the fodder for mass entertainment. When he does find out, the ratings go through the roof and so does the show's creator. (A)

Almost Heroes
 Starring Chris Farley and Matthew Perry
 Playing at Hollywood 16

This probably isn't the worst movie that the late great Chris Farley was involved with — he was in *The Coneheads*, after all — but it is nowhere near the heights he could reach. Rent *Tommy* again for the time being, and check this out when it hits video. Matthew Perry scores most of the screen time and some good lines, but unfortunately the script didn't allow Farley to be the star that he can be. (C-)

Dancer, Texas Pop. 81

Dancer, Texas Pop. 81, in the tradition of recent high-quality independently made comedies from Texas like *Dazed & Confused* and *Bottle Rocket*, does not fail to deliver despite the lack of big names and budget. Tim McCanlies' directorial debut is very funny and relevant to anyone who has spent time in a small town, in Texas or otherwise. *Dancer, Texas* also scores points for the mention of nearby 'Stull Ross College' with its enrollment of 1,800 students and the surrounding population of 6,000. The idea that this is a metropolis to the residents of Dancer gives us a new way to think about life and the people that we know and those that we think we know. *Dancer, Texas* deserves to be a hit. Fear and Loathing in Las Vegas
 The movie adaptation of Hunter S. Thompson's novel could be titled "Lifestyles of the Stoned and Psychotic." Not for everyone with its heavy drug use, but those who enjoy satire of drug culture will dig it. (C+)

Godzilla
 The movie imitates the likes of *King Kong*, *Jurassic Park* and *Aliens* without ever coming close to being a *Godzilla* movie. (D+)

 Bulworth follows the exploits of a senator trying to kill himself. Too bad it's fiction. (B-)

Woo
 The movie suffers from a bad case of cliché-itis, by not breaking any new ground with a familiar concept. Pinkett is charming, but all her cuteness can't save this dull film. (C-)
