Counterfeit tickets sold for finals game

Fans at Utah's Delta Center left without seats for Game 2 Jazz loss to Chicago

SALT LAKE CITY (AP) — About 250 fans bought counterfeit tickets for Game 2 of the NBA Finals on Friday night that were so realistic even Delta Center ticket-takers did not detect them.

Ushers at the game between the Chicago Bulls and Utah Jazz initially believed they were the result



of a computer glitch, which happens occasionally, said Jay Francis, Jazz vice president for marketing.

The bogus tickets "would have fooled me, if I didn't have one to compare it to," Francis said. "It's unfortunate. I know some people paid more than \$500 apiece. People must have lost a lot of money that night."

Police do not know exactly how many. Only about 20 victims reported their loss to police.

The forgeries were printed on heavy ticket-paper stock with the Delta Center logo underneath, carried the standard NBA disclaimer and had only one or two small discrepancies from the real thing.

"They even printed our sponsor's advertisement on the back," Francis said.

One victim later spotted two scalpers who had sold him a pair of fakes for \$300, and alerted police. An Arizona man carrying nearly \$2,000 in cash was arrested Friday, but his companion was not. The suspect was released Saturday after posting bail and has not been charged.

Palmer qualified for U.S. Open

Palmer shot rounds of 74 and 75 at Champions Golf Club in which tied him for second place with Jamie Gomez. The two played in a playoff to determine who would receive the last quality available to the 29-player field.

Former A&M All-American Maggett and David Ogden also qualified in the U.S. Open, which begins Thursday, June 18.

Aggies finish 13th in final ranking

The Texas A&M Women's Team achieved a final ranking of 13 in the Mastercard Team Rankings. The Aggies won their first Conference Championship, earned the GTE Invitational title in February.

Senior Isabelle Rosberg named Big 12 Player of the Year and Jamie Hullett finished with a 76.13 average for the season.

Rupe signs with Tampa Devil Rays

Former Texas A&M right-handed pitcher Ryan Rupe signed with Tampa Bay Devil Rays on Tuesday. Tampa Bay drafted Rupe in the first round of the 1998 Major League Baseball draft.

Rupe posted a career 3.04 ERA with a 4.22 ERA and 281 strikeouts in 300 innings during his A&M career. He was the second pick of the 1998 Aggie Baseball Draft. The New York Mets drafted junior outfielder Jason Tyner as the 21st pick in the first round.
