SALT LAKE CITY (AP) -About 250 fans bought counterfeit tickets for Game 2 of the NBA Finals on Friday night that were so realistic even Delta Center ticket-takers did not detect them.

Ushers at the game between the Chicago Bulls and Utah Jazz initially believed they were the result



The bogus tickets "would have fooled me, if I didn't have

The forgeries were printed on heavy ticket-paper stock with the Delta Center logo underneath, carried the standard NBA disclaimer and had only one or two small dis-

scalpers who had sold him a pair of fakes for \$300, and alerted police. An Arizona man carrying nearly \$2,000 in cash was arrested Friday, but his companion was not. The suspect was released Saturday after posting

Police are seeking other victims who can identify scalpers who sold them tickets, said police spokesman Lt. Phil Kirk.
