**Texas counties surveyed for spaceports**

SAN ANGELO, Texas (AP) — Rocketships in West Texas? Officials in Fort Stockton and Sanderson seem to think it is a good idea. Pecos and Terrell counties are the state's only two inland locations participating in a study of possible spaceport sites, according to the San Angelo Standard-Times. Proponents of the idea say the hot, dry weather and desolate terrain around Fort Stockton and Sanderson could be assets for a launch and re-entry port. The five other areas participating in the study are located along the Gulf Coast: the Brazoria County Partnership, the Chambers-Jefferson Counties Partnership of Southeast Texas, the Galveston County Economic Development Alliance, the Mid-Texas Coast Coalition and a Harlingen-Kingsville partnership.
