

Fans of the television series will be pleased to know "The X-Files" flourishes with the transfer from TV to film. All the old characters, Assistant Director Skinner, Cancer Man and a few others make their way to the screen alongside Mulder and Scully.

Although some people may see this feature-film debut as just an extended television series episode, the scale of the film is so grand, one forgets about the series. The plot of the film and the direction director Rob Bowman takes it in gives followers of the series and newbies to the conspiracy craze a balanced presentation.

For hardcore fans, the season finale flows directly into the film. And for individuals who have never seen the show, it plays out like any other film, but to get lost in if one has not paid attention to the television series.

Duchovny displays a drive in his desire to prove life exists, possibly on Earth. And brings his television character to the screen with more compassion than ever. Mulder is torn between his partner.


