the state Attorney General's office arrived in Jasper on Tuesday to help local prosecutors prepare a capital case against at least two of the three men charged with dragging another man to death alongside a country road.

The state attorneys also will help Jasper officials prepare for a scheduled Saturday rally by visiting Ku Klux Klan members, who authorities fear could attract counterprotests from the New Black Panther Party or other anti-Klan groups.

The three suspects are white, and authorities have identified two of them as having white-supremacist ties.

"Basically what we're doing is expressing our desire on the part of everyone here for any hate groups or groups interested in stirring up trouble to stay away,"

JASPER (AP) — Lawyers from Jasper County Judge Joe Folk Jasper County jail, ne state Attorney General's said. "And we're encouraging Prosecutors will recognize the country of the country (Jasper residents) not to attend the rallies."


