

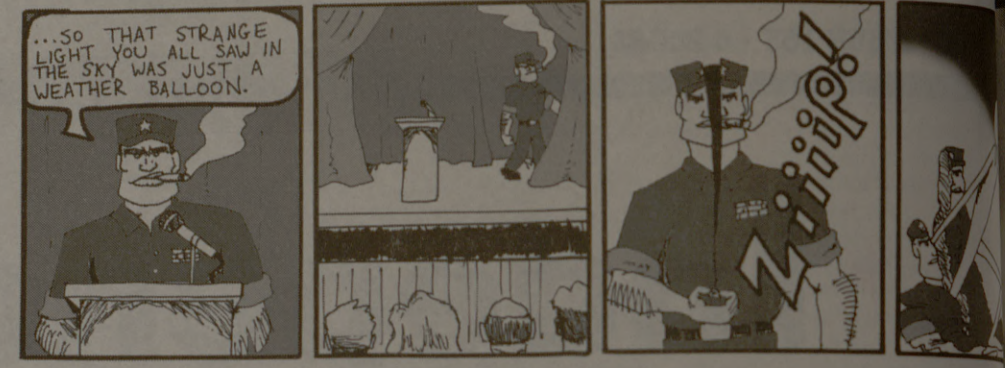

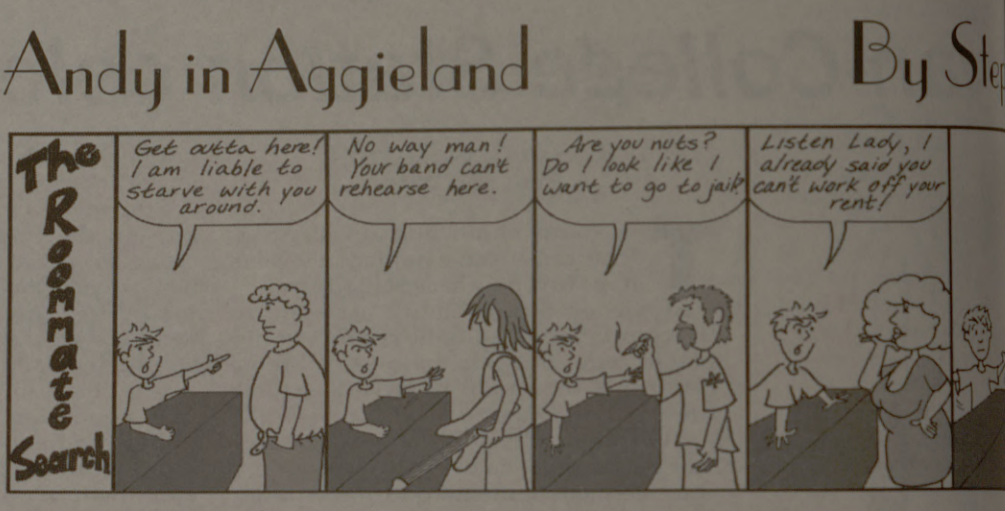
"We're talking to coaches, and I need to hire two more people. We're on it."
