## Jury selection begins for capital murder trial involving former military cadet

NEW BRAUNFELS, Texas (AP) — The next chapter in a grisly tale of high school sex, vengeance and death begins today when former Air Force Academy cadet David Graham goes on trial for capital murder.

Graham, 20, faces life in prison if he is convicted in the shooting death of 16-year-old Adrienne Jones, with whom he allegedly had sex and then helped kill at the behest of his jealous girlfriend, former Naval Academy cadet Diane Zamora.

Zamora was convicted earlier this year in Fort Worth and sentenced to life in prison. At the request of the victim's family, prosecutors decided not to seek the death penalty in either case.

Jury selection in Graham's case begins today. Opening statements are scheduled for July 15.

Graham's attorney, Dan Cogdell, did not return telephone calls from The Associated Press.

But he told *The Dallas Morning News* in a copy-right story that he plans to present a two-pronged defense that will "attack the accuracy" of Graham's lengthy typed confession, as well as the methods that police used to obtain it.

Graham wrote that he and Jones had sex when he drove her home from Mansfield High School after a November 1995 cross-country meet in Lubbock.

Casting doubt on that confession, Cogdell said, is a new prosecution witness and former teammate of Jones who will testify that she — not Graham — drove Jones home.

"That means the whole basis of David's statements would be a lie, and that would play right into my hands," Cogdell said, adding that the witness has refused to speak with his investigator. "That goes right along with my defense."

Lead prosecutor Mike Parrish declined to discuss the new witness, who was subpoenaed by prosecutors after the original Graham trial witness list was filed in April.

"I'm not going to make any comment about a witness that has not already testified," he told *The News*.

Clearly, much of the same evidence presented in

Zamora's trial will surface again.

Despite efforts by Cogdell to exclude the confession, the judge ruled in April it was admissible.

"This man must have had some clue when he started talking to him about Adrienne Jones," the judge said. "He knew they must be focusing on him."

Graham typed the confession while detained in military lockup in Colorado nine months after Dec. 4, 1995, slaying.

According to the statement, Zamora had a back of her parents' car while Graham drove to an isolated lake that December night.

Then Zamora hit Jones over the head with a dumbbell weight and Graham allegedly shot her when she tried to flee.

The two weren't arrested until the following September after they'd both left Texas to attend respective military academies.

In a conversation with another Naval Academy midshipman, Zamora admitted to the slaying, described Jones as a "tramp" who "deserved to die," according to testimony.

Graham's lawyers asked that his trial be held in Fort Worth, the city where her trial was held, national media attention and where her defense attorneys portrayed Graham as domineering and violent.

"The publicity generated about this case is so widespread, inflammatory, adverse and prejudiced as to raise a substantial doubt that a fair trial can obtain a fair trial in Tarrant County, Texas," Cogdell said in a court motion.

State District Judge Don Leonard moved the trial to this Central Texas town of about 30,000, more than 200 miles south of Fort Worth.

He has issued a gag order, and attorneys for both sides have said little publicly later in the trial.

News reporters from more than 20 organizations have descended on New Braunfels, a town on the Guadalupe River that seems most concerned about the moment with its bustling summer tourism.
