## Trial in session

### Zamora expected to appear in court hearing to detail former military cadet's confession

NEW BRAUNFELS (AP) — Former Air Force Academy cadet David Graham's confession that he killed a 16-year-old girl to satisfy his fiancée's demand for "womany vengeance" was read to the jury at his trial Tuesday.

"I just pointed and shot," Graham wrote in his police statement, explaining he fired twice at schoolmate Adrianne Jones with a 9mm Makarov pistol on Dec. 4, 1995.

As his chilling words were read in court, Graham, his family and relatives of Jones sat quietly.

Graham's then-fiancee, Diane Zamora, soon to become a Naval Academy midshipman, demanded the killing because Graham told her he'd had sex one night with Jones, he wrote in the statement.

Zamora felt "betrayed, deceived, and forgotten," Graham wrote.

"When this precious relationship we had was damaged by my thoughtless actions, the only thing that could satisfy her womany vengeance was the life of the one that had, for an instant, taken her place," Graham wrote.

Zamora was convicted of capital murder in February in Fort Worth and is serving a life prison sentence. Graham, 20, faces the same charge and would face the same sentence if convicted since prosecutors are not seeking the death penalty.

Defense attorneys claim Graham falsely confessed to the crime because of his love for Zamora.

They contend Zamora acted alone and that Graham was not present when Jones was killed. His attorneys say Graham helped cover up the crime and told Zamora he would confess along with her if she were ever caught.

Defense and prosecution attorneys claim Graham and Jones never had sex even though he said they did in his confession.

Zamora was transported to New Braunfels yesterday, where she is expected to appear in a court hearing today to determine whether she will be testifying in Graham's trial as a defense witness.

Prosecutors have offered "use testimony immunity" if she is called as a witness, meaning her testimony cannot be used against her in the future. Her attorney, John Lineberger, said he will advise her to assert her Fifth Amendment right not to testify.

Questioned by Tarrant County prosecutor Mike Parrish, Air Force agent Roy Stalvey testified Graham was interviewed at length in September 1996, shortly after he began attending the U.S. Air Force Academy in Colorado.

Graham consented to the interview, but declined to speak with a lawyer, Stalvey said.

In cross-examination by defense attorney Cogdell, Stalvey acknowledged Graham did not provide his written statement until after a Grand Police Department detective who traveled to Fort Worth office told Graham he could face the penalty if convicted.

"You will not concede in front of this jury any sort of threat, will you?" Cogdell asked.

"No sir, I will not," Stalvey said.

The agent also testified Graham was concerned about Zamora's safety during her impending trial and didn't want to provide a statement until she was safe. Investigators told Graham he was allowed to talk with Zamora if he gave a statement, Stalvey testified.

At one point, the agent said, Graham, a friend of his and Zamora's in Fort Worth, urged her to tell Zamora to cooperate with authorities.

Earlier, Stalvey painted a picture of a sometimes cavalier Graham who tried to make investigators guess what he and Zamora used to do in the head before the shooting.

"He would say, 'No, that's not it.' He'd chuckle when we made an incorrect guess. 'You're never going to guess it. It's really Stalvey testified.

Later, Graham told the agents the couple "dumbbell weight," Stalvey said.

Graham and Zamora intended to take a boat to Joe Pool Lake and "break her young neck," Stalvey testified.

"I realized too late that all those quick snapshots seen in the movies were just your Hollywood stunts," Graham wrote.

After hiding in the back of the car, Zamora Jones in the back of the head with one of the while Graham held her, he wrote.

Jones crawled through the car window and aged to run off before collapsing in a field. Stalvey stated, adding that he grabbed the pistol, fired her and shot her twice.

"Diane and I drove off. The first words out of my mouths were, 'I love you,' followed by Diane shouldn't have done that, David," he wrote.

Later in his confession, Graham said he was consumed and by guilt after the slaying.

"I just wanted it to all go away," he wrote. "I was able to be able to drive Adrianne back home, to sleep, and to wake up back on December 3, 1995, make my decisions all over again."

## Memorial for Tejano songstress in need of defacement repairs

CORPUS CHRISTI (AP) — When the Selena Memorial on the bayfront was dedicated one year ago, fans were encouraged to leave handwritten messages to the slain Tejano star on wooden planks that encircle part of the memorial's main column.

Within one month, messages written in blue magic marker and ballpoint pen overflowed onto the column itself, which serves as a backdrop for the bronze Selena sculpture.

Some fans used lipstick to scrawl messages like "We love you, Selena" on the large, sculpted white rose above the dedication inscription.

Plans are in the works to replace the 12 wooden planks with a bronze plaque, warning visitors that graffiti no longer has a place on the bayfront overlook dedicated to Selena's memory. But the local philanthropist who funded the \$600,000 memorial said removing the planks won't discourage people from leaving messages on the statue.

"The boards are serving a purpose," Dusty Durrill, whose Devary Durrill Foundation paid for the memorial, which stands at the entrance of the Peoples Street T-Head said. "It gives people a place to write. Without the boards, they'll write all over the statue."

Selena was gunned down at a local motel March 31, 1995, after achieving international fame for her music. Her former fan club president, Yolanda Saldivar, is serving a life sentence in prison for the murder.

Keeping up with the proliferation of messages at the Selena memorial has become a regular routine for city workers.

Each week, they rub a special solvent on the memorial in an effort to keep the personalized messages off the white center column. The wooden planks are repainted twice a week to keep up with the steady stream
