You've got mail Security breaches online prompt better protection
NEW YORK (AP) — You've heard of the security flaws in Microsoft's and Netscape's popular e-mail programs, and now you're staring suspiciously at every piece of e-mail that lands in your in-box.
Not to worry: There are ways to protect yourself.
The vulnerability allows a harmful file to be attached to an e-mail message and run without the computer user knowing it.
The malicious program could be a destructive virus that erases the hard drive, a "stealth" program that monitors who you send e-mail to and collects their addresses, or it could simply crash the computer.
The security breach affects users of Microsoft's Outlook Express, Outlook 98 and Netscape's e-mail client that comes with Communicator. Millions of people could be affected for months to come.
"This has not struck and done damage yet, but the hacker community does know about it," Gene Hodges, a vice president at the security firm Network Associates, said. "We're going to have them to take advantage of the next few weeks."
Hodges advised users to download the available patches as soon as possible.
Microsoft already has patches for the problem. Web site, but said new patches might be required.
Meng, a product development manager, said any new patches would be available by the end of the week.
Chris Saito, group manager of Netscape, said a secure version of Communicator would be available within weeks. Information is posted on its Web site.
"This is top on my list of threats," Russ Cooper, administrator of a Web page dedicated to Windows security, NTBugtraq, said.
"There's no obvious indication that you've been attacked, but it's possible to see it, but only by the time that's happened too late."
