Lewis, diagnosed with uterine cancer in June, was undergoing chemotherapy when she developed pneumonia and died Sunday at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center, spokesperson Maggie Begley said.

She and members of the family said Lewis was 65, although reference books listed her date of birth as Jan. 17, 1934, which would have made her 64.




