Amy Evans, a freshman biomedical science major who participated in rush convocation, said she was very excited about rush week.

"No one in my family has ever been in a sorority before," Evans said. "I'm really open-minded and excited to be here and to meet a lot of people."

After convocation, the women are divided into groups and introduced to their Rho Chis, trained rush counselors who help the participants.

The Rho Chis are there for the women through out the rush process and will stay with them as long as needed if they did not receive a bid or the bid they wanted.

Karen Barger, 1998-'99 rush chair and a senior majoring in teacher certification, said the Rho Chis and the members of the Panhellenic Council, are unaffiliated with their chapters during rush preparation so they can give participants a fair chance during rush.

"The Rho Chis have been in training since February or March and are trained pretty extensively to handle the women," she said.

Barger said many of the women are vulnerable during the rush process because it is the first college experience for many of them.

"For a lot of them, it's a family thing and a lifetime commitment, and it doesn't always work out the way they want it to," she said.

The night before rush, the

women are asked to get a good night's rest and to wear comfortable shoes the next day.

The five days of rush consists of small parties, where rush participants are allowed to meet the members of each of the 12 Panhellenic chapters.

During the parties, the chapters perform skits showing the women what each chapter has to offer. Parties last between 20 minutes to an hour, depending on the day of the week.

The women are asked to dress nicely and not to do things such as chew gum or carry cell phones.

Barger said the parties and activities of rush week are nothing like the false stereotypes portrayed in movies, and alcohol is not involved.

"Movies are such a farce on what really goes on," Barger said.
