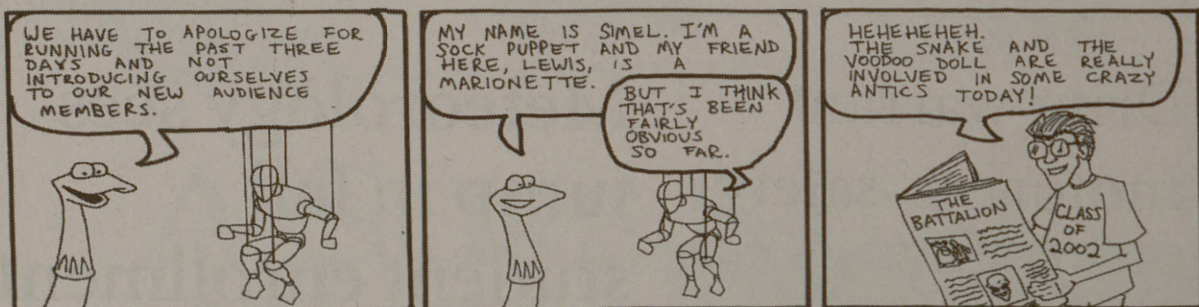

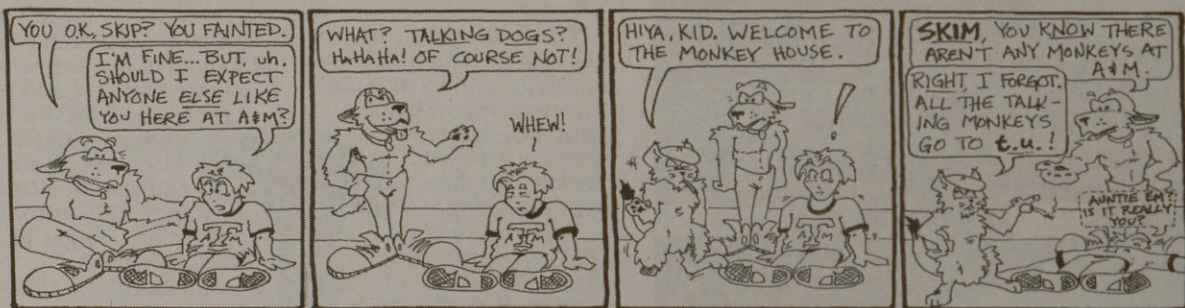

Ross Street to remain one way

Ross Street will remain a one-way street for the next few years. Doug Williams, assistant director of the Department of Parking, Traffic and Transportation Services, said the plans to fix Ross Street coincide with the construction of a new chemical engineering building set to begin in the year 2000.

Utilities will have to be placed underneath Ross Street, so repairs to the road and construction on the new building will be done simultaneously. The repairs to Ross Street are estimated to cost around \$1 million.
