Bush starts camp with East Texas

KILGORE, Texas (AP) — Republican Gov. George W. Bush toured East Texas on Tuesday, promising voters that schoolchildren and taxpayers would be his priorities in a second term.

"This election isn't over. In fact it's just beginning," Bush said during a four-city bus tour. "I intend to be the first governor in our state's history to win back-to-back four-year terms."

Bush has held substantial leads in several recent polls. Over the weekend a survey by *The Dallas Morning News* and *Houston Chronicle* showed Bush leading Democrat Garry Mauro by a 70 percent to 21 percent margin.

Calling education his top priority, Bush said he did not want to hear about schoolchildren in Texas failing standardized reading tests. He said about 40,000 students did not pass the standardized reading

tests last year.

Bush said he would request an additional \$1 billion for the next two-year budget for education.

"First and foremost, we will prioritize the schools right behind the taxpayers of East Texas," Bush said.

Karen Hughes, Bush's spokeswoman, said he wants to send \$2 million to each of the 10- to 15 local property tax districts.

Bush also said he would vote another \$1 billion for local funds for local use for hiring more teachers, building classrooms.

The money was projected revenue, Bush said.

"We've got a surplus, not a deficit," Bush said.

Death row inmate demands request to donate organs

AUSTIN (AP) — A death row inmate facing execution next month has been blocked by prison officials from donating his organs.

Convicted killer Jonathan Nobles is scheduled to die Oct. 7 for killing two Austin women, Kelly Joan Farquhar, 24, and Mitzi Johnson Nalley, 21, after breaking into their Austin home in 1986.

Nobles told the *Austin American-Statesman* he is prepared to die for what he did but also wants to do something positive after "bringing so much darkness into this world." He insisted the donation attempt is not a ploy to have his sentence commuted.

"People out there who need organs are more than willing to accept inmate organs," he said.

"There are sins as well as sins of omission. I can't do anything but what I can do."

The Texas Department of Criminal Justice's organ donation policy says the state will not transport a donor for the surgery unless the donor pays the costs of guarding the donor.
