

## Starr says inquiry cost \$4.4 million

WASHINGTON (AP) - Independent Counsel Kenneth Starr spent at least \$4.4 million investigating the alleged cover-up of the Monica Lewinsky affair — a figure that became an instant political weapon in the debate over penal-izing President Clinton.

Sen. Frank Murkowski, R-Alaska, introduced a Senate resolution Tuesday that would demand Clinton repay the cost of the investigation for misleading the country since January.

"President Clinton has pursued a strategy of deceiving the American people and Congress, and he purposely delayed and impeded the independent counsel investigation," Murkowski said. "Equity demands that the costs of the delays should be borne by the president and not the taxpayers.

Many Democrats are already advocating a penalty less than impeachment for Clinton, such as a censure and reimbursement arrangement similar to the reprimand and penalty House Speak-

er Newt Gingrich got in a ethics case. The White House left open
