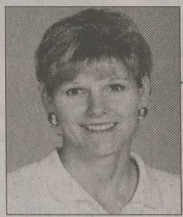
The Aggies take to the road for their next match, traveling to Palo Alto, Ca., to take on Stanford University Sunday afternoon.
