Running with the 'Big' boys
 Look no further than the Big 12 Conference
 of running backs that lead the nation in rushing

The Big 12 Conference stabilized its reputation as a top football conference with its 15-5 record in non-conference contests this season. Two of those losses were to highly ranked Florida State and UCLA.

and scored an eye-popping 38 touchdowns that year.

Big 12 backs also finished first and second in national rushing in each of the past two years with Troy Davis of Iowa State and Texas Tech's Byron Hanspard both eclipsing the 2,000-yard mark in 1996, and UT's Williams and Nebraska's Ahman Green leading in 1997.

Iowa State's Dan McCarney coached Troy Davis and now coaches Davis' brother Darren.

"It's hard to compare," he said, "but I can't imagine a better collection of backs than what there is in the Big 12 Conference."

Born to Run

The Big 12 Conference has the top three rushing yardage leaders in the nation this season. Missouri's Devin West (No. 1, 222.0 yards per game), Texas Tech's Ricky Williams (No. 2, 210.5 ypg) and Texas' Ricky Williams (No. 3, 187.5 ypg) pace the NCAA this year.

Rushing dominance is nothing new to the conference. Six of the top 10 single-season totals have been recorded by Big 12 performers.

Oklahoma State's Barry Sanders still holds the most impressive single year in NCAA history. Sanders rushed for 2,628 net yards in 1988

Funnin' 'n Gunnin' with the Huskers

Nebraska is 12-12 in the "red zone" this season, the area from the 20-yard line to the end zone.

The fact that Nebraska's offense is efficient is no surprise, but the way in which they are getting it done is a surprise.

The Cornhuskers have passed for 150 yards in three straight games, something unusual for the option-oriented club.

"It's not a change in philosophy," Nebraska coach Frank Solich said. "We have a good throwing quarterback, all of our receivers are back and they run good routes. We have a young offensive line and teams have been lining up eight-

"We think that both he [Spiller] and Dan are guys that we can put in the ball game and they can be productive members of our offensive football team," Hollingshead said.

Combined with Campbell, the Aggies have an alternative in almost any situation through the tight ends.

Campbell averages over 12 yards per reception with 246 total yards in 20 catches, making him yet another option for the Aggies in tight situations.

"We work great together," senior tight end Dan Campbell said. "We've got a big play threat in him [Spiller] and a possession receiver in me, and we both block well."

Regardless of the situation, Hollingshead said Spiller's hands and blocking can be counted on to get the job done.

Against Southern Mississippi, the Aggies will need that clutch performer they can depend on.

Gailey takes responsibility for poor defensive performance

IRVING, Texas (AP) — The Dallas Cowboys could usually count on their defense to keep them in the game.

They didn't Sunday, and suddenly, solid defense is a problem for the Cowboys who rank No. 23 in the NFL after being No. 2 last year.

The defending Super Bowl champion Denver Broncos, behind John Elway, went over, through and around the Cowboys in a 42-23 humiliation Sunday that stunned the defensive coaches and players.

The Cowboys coaches and players had to admit they were out-schemed by Denver coach Mike Shanahan.

"It's hard for linebackers to cover wide receivers and tight ends and that's the position we got caught in at times," said linebacker Randall Godfrey. "We couldn't adjust until halftime."

Safety Darren Woodson said the Broncos "came out with a different game plan. We didn't match and we didn't cover. We were all over the place."
