Soccer hits the road for Pal

On the road again. Just can't wait to get on the road again.

The Texas A&M Soccer Team heads out on the road once again where they have found considerable success this season. So far, the Aggies are 2-0 away from the Aggie Soccer Complex, outscoring the opposition 5-2 at the Wisconsin Invitational.

The destination this time is Palo Alto, Calif., where the seventh-ranked Aggies travel to take on the 22nd-ranked Stanford University Cardinal at 3 p.m. Sunday at New Maloney Field.

The match-up with Stanford is a return engagement from the Aggies' second game last year, a game won by the Aggies 2-1 on their home field. Departed All-American Bryn Blalack scored two goals in a 30 second span in the second half to lead A&M to victory.

"Anyone who saw the game last year against Stanford saw that it was a nip and tuck game," A&M soccer coach G. Guerrieri said. "It was a very back and forth game. Really, it could've gone either way."

Guerrieri said he thinks this year's game will provide much of the same.

"The fact that [last year's game] was at home for us was a huge advantage. I know that the coach of Stanford will have his team well prepared. A lot of the players for Stanford all have this game circled on their calendars."

Overall on the year, the Cardinals coming off a road trip in which including a loss to Big 12 runner-up, midfielder Tracy Lawyer paced goals on the season. Goalkeeper defender Jill Buxton lead a defense goals per game.

Texas A&M, 5-1 overall on the game riding a three-game winning streak.

Defensively, the Aggies look to opposition out of the net. Along with Emily Elias, Ashley Fendley are only allowed opponents four goals.

The Aggies return home Sep. 27 against former Southwest Conference Methodist University at the Aggie

Cowboys' Garrett 'not a handi

EAST RUTHERFORD, N.J. (AP) — Facing Jason Garrett instead of Troy Aikman does not give the New York Giants as big an advantage as you might think against the Dallas Cowboys on Monday night.

Backups, and even rookie quarterbacks, have done remarkably well playing against New York since Jim Fassel took over as coach, which scares some Giants defenders.

"I got one word for you," Giants safety Percy Ellsworth said, then paused. "Jacksonville."

Just to jog the memory, third-string quarterback Steve Matthews made his first NFL start against the Giants last year because of injuries to Mark Brunell and Rob Johnson. He completed 23 of 35 passes for 252 yards in a 40-13 Jaguars win.

Arizona's Jake Plummer, making only his fourth start, set an NFL rookie passing record throwing of 388 yards in a 19-10 Giants win on Nov. 16.

Even in this year's season-opening 31-24 win against Washington, Trent Green came off the bench and hit 15 of his first 16 passes for two touchdowns to scare New York.


Now comes Garrett, making only his third start in six years.

He completed 14 of 19 passes for 113 yards after Aikman broke his left collarbone in the second quarter of the Cowboys' 42-23 loss to Denver on Sunday. The former Princeton star led Dallas to a 42-31 win over the Redskins in his start in 1994.
