to understand why Steamroller is an Austin favorite. The band has released two albums on its own Redwood Records label, Steamroller in 1995 and Cabin Fever in 1997. The latter reached #2 best-selling local album at Austin's Tower Records in less than one week, no small feat considering virtually all of its competition was backed by a major label.

Although Steamroller remains fiercely independent (the band is "effectively self-managed" according to its press kit), it seems the guys are doing remarkably well for themselves without the support of a label or any outside management.
