A&M has a chance to get in conference play with the next four games in the conference of G. Rollie White Coliseum against Texas, Kansas State, Kansas and Oklahoma.

The Aggies need to make the most of this scheduling opportunity, because their next three games will be on the road the rest of October.

Playing up to Expectations
When the 1998 season was over, the Aggies took the court for one senior and two returning starters.

Senior All-American Stacy Sykora and junior All-American Woolsey were expected to be the most of the pressure on the young team.

So far, they have done well and more. Sykora tied or led the team in nine of 10 matches, led in digs in all but three of A&M's matches.

In seven of the Aggies' matches, she led the team in both kills and digs.

For the season, Sykora led the team with 5.06 kills per game and 4.10 digs per game. She has reached double figures in kills in every match and has led in digs in eight of 10 matches.

Woolsey has also carried a heavy load for the team. She posted career-high in blocks with 1.65 last Friday against No. 25 Tech. She is averaging 1.65 blocks per game, which is a career high for her.
