

"Some places have been leaking for 22 years and there are cracks, but the only way it would be unsafe is if there is a severe earthquake," he said.

But anyone visiting the fourth floor of Building A can see there is a big problem.

There is an approximately sixinch separation between the beams. Claycamp said the minor prob-

lems with the architecture building require proper upkeep, which is costly.

"It does require expensive maintenance, probably more maintenance than most of the buildings," he said. "It may be sick, but it is not unsafe."

The Langford Building has had several notable events take place. in its halls including an evacuation caused by the last of two bomb threats on November 29, 1983. Twenty years and one day after


the first dedication of the building, there was a break-in over Spring Break in 1987, resulting in a \$14,000 loss of computers and student work.

A second evacuation was needed because of smoke infiltration from a generator in 1995.

The Langford Building has also showcased numerous art exhibits and film festivals, including an "ethnic identity" film festival in 1989.
