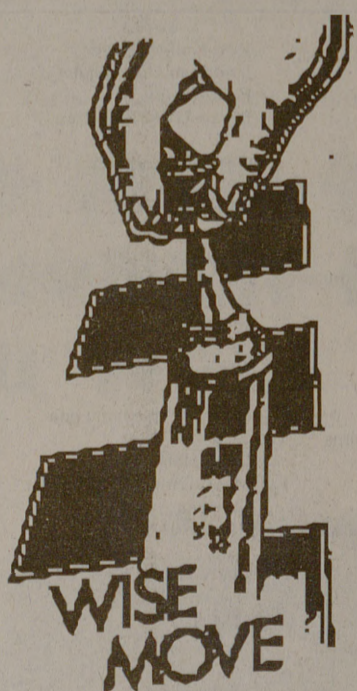

Three Ags qualify for ITA tourney

Three members of the ranked Texas A&M Men's Team earned a spot in the qualifying round of the ITA All-American Championships, the Penick-Allison Tennis Series at the University of Texas in El Paso.

Sophomore Shaun Aramburo was an automatic entry in the qualifying round of the ITA. He brings a 2-1 overall record to the tournament. He will face Adrian Barnes of the University of California in the first round.

Junior Juan Aramburo qualified for the 64-man tourney after winning his portion of the qualifying round earlier in the week. Aramburo ousted his opponents, including Nebraska's Jorge Abos Sanchez in the first round, 2-6, 6-7, (6, 5).

Aramburo is in the midst of a 14-match winning streak as he has compiled a 14-0 all record, including winning only Big 12 match. He will face William Farah of Michigan in the opening round.

Against Kansas State, she was the match leader in kills with 28 and she tied a career-high with seven blocks.

She posted double-digit kills in both matches to give her 100 the season.

Her 4.54 dig average and .285 kill average both lead the Big 12 and rank sixth and 11th in the nation, respectively.
