he Benz Gallery of Floral Art is hosting an exhibit of a different nature. The gallery located in the horticulture building is home to the "Gifts from around the World.

The gifts are property of the L.T. Jordan Institute for International Awareness in the Memorial Student Center. The institute was founded after Jordan's wife,

Jessie, gave the MSC a million dollar endowment. The Jordan Institute helps students develop leadership skills and pursue international internships. It also houses a collection of gifts and art obtained

while the Jordans were overseas. This collection is the focus of the Benz Gallery exhibit. The pieces chronicle the Jordans' 30 years in various foreign countries such as Venezuela and Kuwait.

Luke Altendorf, director of the Jordan Institute, said the collection offers history and culture.

"It is like a small museum," he said. Some of the more unique pieces include a silver tea set with gold roses and a coffin-shaped humidor with a silver boat. Both pieces were collected during the Jordans' time in Kuwait.


