Texas quarterbacks sets school record

DALLAS (AP) — Texas quarterback Major Applewhite and backup Kris Stockton, and Missouri quarterback Wade Perkins have each named the Big 12's player of the week.

Applewhite, a redshirt freshman, set a school record for completions and yards by going 29-of-40 with one interception and three touchdowns in the Longhorns' 37-34 victory over Oklahoma State. He improved to 6-1 as a starter and tied another school record with his seventh straight yard game.

Stockton clinched the title with a 29-yard field goal with seconds left. The Longhorns called a timeout to set up a kick, then the Cowboys made three straight timeouts to keep him thinking about it more. He pulled up banking it in off the left side. Stockton also made kicks of 45 yards and hit four point attempts. Perkins, a senior, had a solo tackle and two assists. A 15-year sack, an interception he deflected a pass as the beat Colorado 38-14. Perkins was his national-leading passer the year and put him one step away from the school record.

UT guard Vazquez to miss 3 games

AUSTIN (AP) — Because of an injury during the Texas Tech game, eighth scholarship player Vazquez will miss an extra game and possibly the first two regular-season games because of a knee injury.

Vazquez is scheduled to have surgery Tuesday morning to repair a torn meniscus in his left knee. He will not be back for Wednesday's game against Australian All-Stars and is expected to return to play against Houston on Nov. 23 and South Florida on Nov. 25.

HARRIERS

Arturo Barrios, a former A&M cross country runner, has been elected to the Texas Hall of Fame.

While at A&M, he received All-American honors in the 10,000-meter run and cross-country in 1985. After graduating, he set the 1988 Olympics and set a world record in the 10,000-meter (1989) and the 20,000-meter (1991) and the one-hour run (1991).

Track and Field News has ranked A&M's 1998 Women's Track and Field Recruiting Class No. 5 nationally. Of those individuals mentioned as standouts, two were cross-country runners.

They were freshman Melissa Gulli of Klein High School and Kayci Waters of Devine High School.

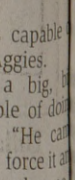
