Trinity River

Death row inmate Martin Gurule, the subject of a massive manhunt since he escaped the Ellis Unit on Thanksgiving night, was found dead in the Trinity River about a mile away Thursday

Gurule's bloated corpse was discovered about 5:30 p.m. beneath a bridge by two off-duty prison employees fishing near the community of Riverside, said prison spokesman Larry Todd. "We are confirming it is him,

based upon the prison clothing that he was wearing and based upon facial features," Todd said. 'The body had deterioriated from being under water The body was found about a

mile east of the prison at the mouth of Harmon Creek, which empties into the Trinity River.

"It was clearly the insense pressure put on him by search teams and dogs and horseback that forced him to swim Harmon Creek," spokesperson Larry Fitzgerald said.

The creek and river had been swift from recent rains.
