

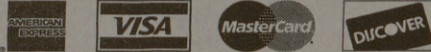

Rockets' Barkley weighing options

LA QUINTA, Calif. (AP) — Although Charles Barkley is expected to re-sign with Houston, on Wednesday he said the Rockets are among three teams he's considering.
"I'll decide between the Atlanta Hawks, Houston and the Seattle SuperSonics," the free agent forward said. "I'm just trying to decide who has the best chance to win a championship."
He added with a grin: "I'm going to consult with my financial adviser, Michael (Jordan), and make a decision by the end of the week. In the meantime, I'm just going to play some golf."
Barkley was on the driving range at Bermuda Dunes Country Club, waiting to tee off in the Bob Hope Chrysler Classic. He, Jordan and former NFL receiver Roy Green were the amateurs playing in a foursome with the PGA's Payne Stewart.
The Rockets' acquisition of Scottie Pippen from Chicago should provide Barkley added incentive to return to Houston.
He, Pippen and Hakeem Olajuwon would give the Rockets an imposing front line, and

Arbitration hearings for Rangers' players

ARLINGTON, Texas (AP) — Salary arbitration hearings may be on the horizon for the Texas Rangers after a two-year respite, because offers between the ball club and two of the three remaining eligible players are more than \$1 million apart.
Aaron Sele has asked for \$6.25 million, while the Rangers offered \$4.8 million, which would be the biggest single-season salary for a starter in team history. Sele earned \$2.85 million last year, with \$35,000 of that coming from incentives.
Rangers General Manager Doug Melvin is unsure whether the team can reach a settlement with Sele, who went 19-11 this past season with a 4.23 ERA in 33 starts.
Designated hitter Lee Stevens wants to more than double the \$1.25 million he earned last year, including \$50,000 through incentives. He's asking for \$2.65 million, while the Rangers have offered \$1.5 million. Stevens hit .265 with 20 home runs this past season.
Reliever Tim Lincecum has asked for \$875,000, and the team

has offered \$625,000.

Supreme Court hears athletics bias lawsuit

WASHINGTON (AP) — A lawsuit drafted by a rookie law student angry that she was denied a spot on her college volleyball team will help the Supreme Court answer whether the NCAA is subject to federal discrimination laws.
The NCAA told the court Wednesday that a key anti-bias law guaranteeing federal protection against sex discrimination in most schools does not apply to it.
"The NCAA is an association of its members and its members... receive federal money. The NCAA does not," argued the tax-exempt organization's lawyer, John G. Roberts Jr.
Roberts said a federal appeals court was wrong when it ruled that the NCAA is an indirect recipient of federal aid because of the dues it collects from its 1,200 member schools.
The federal law known as Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 applies only to educational programs receiving federal money.
The Supreme Court is expected to rule in Renee Smith's case by summer. If the court allows her to continue her lawsuit, the NCAA could be on the hook in a host of other discrimination lawsuits based on race or disability, both sides have said.
The NCAA argues that individual universities are fair game for

discrimination complaints, she said it is a step removed.
"You don't just follow the money," Roberts argued.
Smith, 26, sued in federal court after the NCAA said she was ineligible for the volleyball teams at two schools where she did postgraduate work.
"I want to establish a precedent, so other intercollegiate athletes don't have to start at the side of the road," Smith said Wednesday.
The NCAA first judged ineligible in 1993, based on the sports organization's rule. Although Smith had two years of eligibility remaining after her early graduation from St. Bonaventure upstate New York, she lost when she moved to Hofstra Hempstead, N.Y., for graduate school, the NCAA said.
The NCAA refused to grant Smith a waiver.
Smith tried again when she went to law school at University of Pittsburgh in 1995. Again, the NCAA denied a waiver.
Smith sued in 1996, after completing her first year of school, alleging that the NCAA was more inclined to grant waivers to male student athletes.
Her lawyer argued the NCAA should be subject to the discrimination rules its members follow.
