PALM BEACH, Fla. (AP) — Is Bob Dole a funny guy?

Chinese Gymnast Sang returns home

NEW YORK (AP) — Paralyzed gymnast Sang Lan can go home to China in June, her doctors say. "I'm very happy to go back," the 17-year-old said. "But I will miss New York."

Sang will live with her parents in Beijing after seeing them infrequently over the years because of her training schedule.

She was injured in a fall during a practice vault July 21 at the Goodwill Games.

She was paralyzed from the neck down but has regained some strength in her shoulders, elbows and wrists and can raise her

arms.

Vice President Al Gore's wife, Tipper, presented Sang with an award for courage Tuesday from Women's Sports and Fitness magazine. She also received an award from *Cosmopolitan*.

Elfman chooses art over fame

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Jenna Elfman likes performing more than she likes being a star.

"It's not my goal to be famous," said the "Dharma & Greg" co-star. "It's my goal to inspire and touch people the way I love to be inspired and touched by other people."

Elfman is appearing in "Visions and Lovers: Variations on a Theme," a play that opens Saturday at a small theater in Los Angeles, and co-stars in the upcoming Ron Howard movie *Ed TV*.

Bantam Books Glenn's choice

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. (AP) — John Glenn picked Bantam Books from among the publishers courting him for a memoir.

The autobiography is due out this fall, Bantam said Wednesday. Barb Burg, a Bantam spokesperson, would not disclose how much he will be paid.

"We never do," she said. Glenn's only other book is "We Seven," a 1962 collaboration with

the six other Mercury

He had so many other memoirs after he became the most famous person in space.

Glenn, 77, was the first to orbit the Earth and returned to space on the shuttle *Discovery* last year.

His book will chronicle his 55-year marriage to his wife, Annie Glenn, and his 24 years in the U.S. Senate.

"He's been working on this for a long time," said Glenn, who retired from the Senate last month.

He wrote a book with Nick Taylor, a former member of his parents' band, *Necessary End*.

Critics name Spacey best actor

LONDON (AP) — Kevin Spacey was named best actor by the London Critics Circle for his performance in a stage production of Eugene O'Neill's *Long Day's Journey Into Night*.

He reprises the part of a man who later this season, in *Monday Morning*.

Two years ago, Spacey won the Critics' Circle award for best director for *Man of the Year* (1997); and the Royal Theatre revival of "Oklahoma!" (1998).

Most promising player in the 2000s to 26-year-old Rebecca Pidgeon for "Yard Gal."

The Critics' Circle membership consists of leading theater and magazine theater critics from London.
