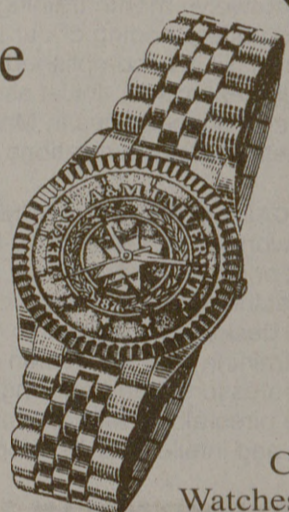

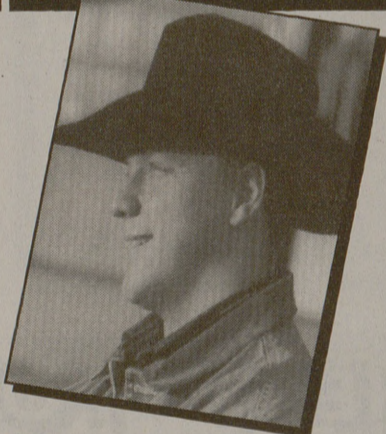

- student garage priority spaces will increase from \$270 per year to \$396
- student general parking (red and blue) lots will increase from \$75 per year to \$125
- faculty and staff (yellow) lots will increase from \$100 per year to \$132
- faculty non-numbered, gated lots will increase from \$100 per year to \$198
- faculty reserved, numbered spaces will increase from \$200 per

year to \$264

- motorcycle permits will increase from \$35 per year to \$48
- night access permits will increase from \$35 per year to \$48
- park-and-ride permits will increase from \$35 per year to \$48

Peter Schulte, chair of the parking sub-committee for Student Senate and a junior business major, said the increase is the first in several years.

He said all parking-facility construction is funded by increases like this one.

"Everything that has to do with parking is funded through PTTs'

budget, which is parking fees, permits and citations," he said.

He said Student Senate will take student opinions into account concerning the increase recommendations.

"Student Senate is looking into student reactions to the increase and will vote on a resolution showing students' opinions," he said.

Schulte said the task force members continued to define, at their meeting last Friday, the parking problems they will address throughout the term of the team's existence. He said they have begun to categorize their assignments.

## Student rally encourages abstinence

A student-sponsored rally will address risks and encourage abstinence from the MSC.

Speakers at the Aggieland Abstinence Confront the Medical Aspects and Risks of Pregnancy and the Idea of Sex as a Gift from Margaret Griffith, health education officer for A.P. Beutal Health Center said some people take abstinence for virginity.

"You can practice abstinence even after being sexually active," she said.

Micah Wing, chaplain of Aggies Sisters and a sophomore biomedical science student, said the rally will spread an important message. Wing said people assume everyone is wishing to prevent pregnancy, so they take precautions before marriage.

Wing said condoms are effective in preventing pregnancy and disease, and birth control protect against pregnancy.

She said abstinence is the only foolproof way to prevent pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases.

"Abstinence will guard you from some of the other precautions will not," Wing said. "It is the emotional scars."
