Chicago (AP) — David Robinson scored 22 points and ex-Bull Steve Kerr got his ring, then found his 3-point touch Sunday to help San Antonio beat Chicago 89-76 in his return to the United Center.

The loss marked Chicago's first three-game losing streak at home in five years since Michael Jordan was off playing baseball.

The Spurs held a one-point lead when Kerr, who received his championship ring in a pregame ceremony, hit consecutive 3-pointers — the second right in front of the Bulls bench — giving San Antonio a 68-61 lead in the fourth.

A member of the past three title teams in Chicago, Kerr was only 3-for-13 on threes entering the game. He connected on 3-of-3 Sunday and finished with 11 points.

LAS VEGAS (AP) — Respect. Oscar De La Hoya earned it by outpointing Ike Quartey, then said he gave his opponent too much of it in the fight.

"I've just got to go out there and fight," the WBC welterweight champion said of his split-decision victory Saturday night.

De La Hoya, who had said Quartey would be the toughest test of his career, got up from a sixth-round knockdown, won the last three rounds on all three cards and knocked down the challenger and almost stopped him in the 12th round.

"I beat one of the best in the world out there," said De La Hoya, now 30-0, with 24 knockouts. Quartey of Ghana, a former WBA champion who was stripped of that title, lost for the first time against 34 wins, 29 by knockouts, and one draw.

There was talk of a rematch, as there always is after a good fight.

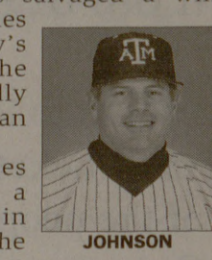
