Career Center offers aid for students

The Career Center in the John J. Koldus Building offers career education, experience through co-op and interning and interviews with various companies to students deciding on their future career paths.

Glen Payne, associate director of placement at the Career Center, said some students utilize the center's resources when choosing a major or deciding they need guidance on planning their future.

"Students can get information on interning and co-oping companies they are interviewing with and career education through our program," he said. "We do suggest that students register early and take full advantages of our services."

Programs are provided for all students, especially those looking for

full-time employment after graduation.

The Dress for Success program will address proper interview attire. The Career Center is also offering resume writing and job hunting programs.

The Anderson Consulting Career Resource Library, a component of the Career Center, offers company directories and career books aiding in planning and searching for jobs.

Pat Johnson Alexander, associate director for career education, said students are utilizing the libraries' resources, but students should start their research early.

"Students need to start researching at least two semesters [prior to graduating]," she said. "Being familiar with companies is better, and doing it all your last semester, that can be extremely stressful."

Company profiles and education books are available according to major. Career information is offered at where students can make

Payne said the Career Center hired career counselors to promote its services.

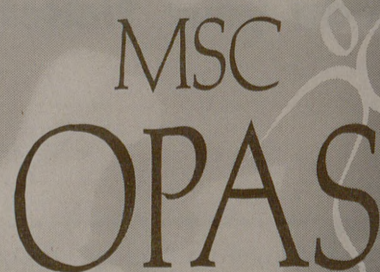
