work 8 to 5," he said. Maj. Curt Carver, a member of the gold team and a computer science graduate student, said the class provides students an opportunity to learn through participa-

Marti said the goal of the black team is to recognize the weaknesses in the gold team's network system and attack the system without being detected.

"It's no good to break into the system and be detected," he said. "You don't break into a store just to get your face on a video and leave your wallet on the counter. Students are learning how to break-in, steal the information and not be detected by the gold
