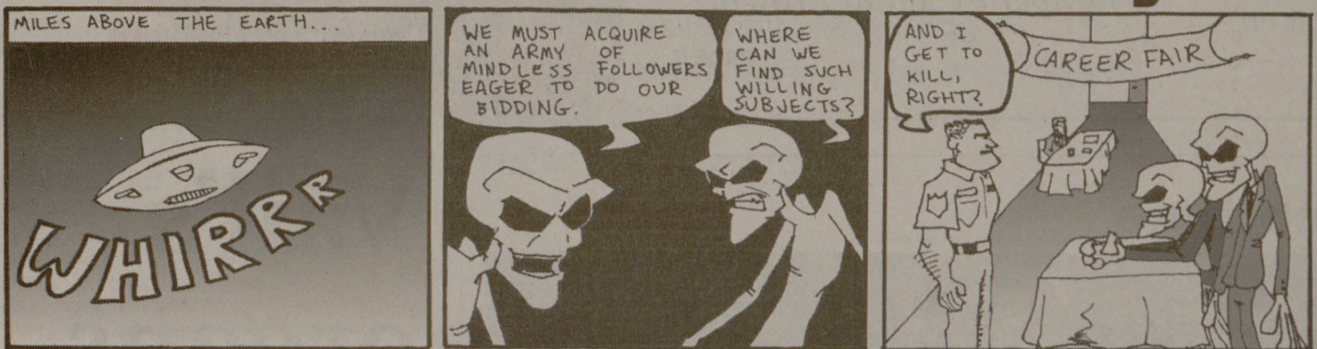
The information said fewer than half of families approached to donate a family member's organs agree to do so.

She said participants do not need to bring partners, and a potluck lunch will precede the game.

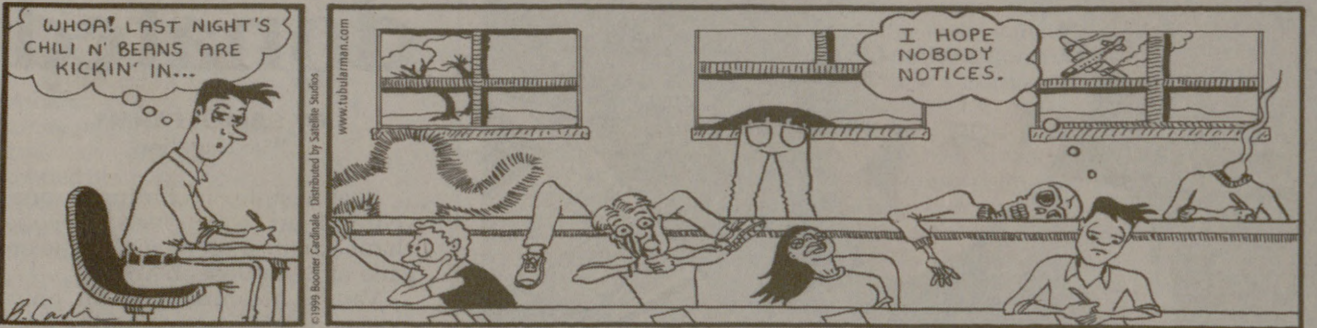
#### Lecture focuses on flexibility, strength
