

Texas A&M University's Prissy Sharpe was named to the All-Big 12 Women's Basketball Second

Team on Sunday. The sophomore forward ranked among the Big 12's top 10 in points (18.3, fourth), rebounds (9.0, secsions Brent Horan and (18.3, fourth), rebounds (9.0, second), field-goal percentage (.456, ninth) and free-throw percentage

(.792, 10th). Texas Tech University center Angie Braziel, who led the conference in points and blocks, was voted Big 12 Player of the Year by the conference's coaches.
