## Duke's Brand leads All-America Team

(AP) — Elton Brand, who missed almost half his freshman season with a broken foot, became a year later the only unanimous choice on the 1998-99 Associated Press All-America Team.

The 6-foot-8 sophomore center was named Monday on the first team by junior forward Richard Hamilton of Connecticut and senior guards Andre Miller of Utah and Jason Terry of Arizona, and junior guard Mateen Cleaves of Michigan State.

Brand, who averaged 17.8 points and 9.8 rebounds for the top-ranked Blue Devils, was named on all 72 first-team ballots by the national media panel to become the fourth unanimous selection of the '90s. The others were Christian Laettner of Duke in 1992, Glenn Robinson of Purdue in 1994 and Tim Duncan of Wake Forest in 1997.

"It's unbelievable. I'm just elated right now. Just to have been considered for a position of first-team All-America is a special, special honor," Brand, who shot 62 percent from the field, said. "I knew I worked hard, and

the hard work paid off. I got up it's one of the things I've always dreamed of. I'm definitely a team person, and the accolades come when you win."

Brand was an honorable mention All-America last year despite missing 15 games because of the injury, but he showed signs of improvement when he led the team in scoring with 20.5 points per game in the second half of the season. He averaged 5-3-1 in the second half of the season, getting 33.3 percent of the total votes. Western State Conference MVP of the year, Brand averaged 25.7 points, 5.7 assists and 2.5 rebounds, and the 6-2 guard was given credit for his team leadership statistics.

"It's a real honor. I don't take the credit myself because we have a great team and I deserve the award," Brand said. "It makes being a team player a lot easier when you have a team like we have."

## Silas replaces Cowens as new Hornets coach

Former assistant takes over troubled team  
FORT MILL, S.C. (AP) — Paul Silas took over as the Charlotte Hornets' coach Monday, pledging to try to revive a franchise beset by poor play, weak leadership and injuries.

"Where this thing is going, who the heck knows? Hopefully miracles do happen," Silas said after running a two-hour practice at the team's training complex.

Silas was named Charlotte's interim coach one day after the resignation of Dave Cowens, a close friend and former teammate with the Boston Celtics in the 1970s.

Cowens, who led Charlotte to back-to-back 50-victory seasons in his first two years in Charlotte, stepped down because of mounting frustration with owner George Shinn's refusal to give him a raise.

Cowens' inability to work out a deal with Shinn was just one of several problems associated with a club that is off to a 4-11 start and has seen a significant drop in attendance.

Some fans are calling on Shinn to sell the team if he continues to refuse to pay the money needed to retain top talent. Injuries have sidelined the team's best two players, and one of them, leading scorer Glen Rice, is the subject of talks with the Lakers.

Considering those circumstances, Silas acknowledged, new job does not exactly look like the chance of a lifetime.

"But I've been through this before," he said. "When you coach the Clippers, it's a tough job."

Silas coached the Clippers when they were located in San Diego from 1980-83. He has coached an NBA assistant for the past 10 years, the last two in Charlotte. When Cowens told him of the job, Silas said he would not relent, and he became a logical successor. "In a religion, you have three assistants with NBA coaching experience," Silas said. "The fans have to look at the team and see whether we're making progress or not," he said. "We're playing hard? Are we getting their money's worth? Are things that have occurred, I really be concerned about my players at this point."
