# Man executed for 1981 murd

HUNTSVILLE(AP) - Charles Rector, claiming his innocence to the end, was executed Thursday night for the abduction, rape, shooting and drowning of an Austin woman more than 17 years

Rector was pronounced dead at 6:22 p.m., eight minutes after the lethal drugs began flowing into his

"I want you to know I'm not guilty," Rector said in a final state-ment while strapped to the death chamber gurney.

He turned his head and looked at five members of Carolyn Kay

Davis' family.

"And I'll say this to the family — I did not kill your daughter. Take it the way you want. I'm sorry for the pain," he said.

Rector expressed love to members of his family, who also watched through another window. He concluded his statement by reciting the words to a song he wrote, called "God Living With Us 24 Hours.

One of his witnesses, a sister, fainted and had to be assisted out of the viewing area after Rector had slipped into unconsciousness.

Among Rector's witnesses was former Dallas Cowboy Thomas 'Hollywood'' Henderson, now an Austin businessman active in community programs.
