Pro-life feminist to speak

BY MELISSA JORDAN The Battalion Serrin Foster, executive director of Feminists for Life of America will break the stereotype of feminists supporting the pro-life movement with her lecture, "Feminist Case Against Abortion" at 7 p.m. in 601 Rudder.

Kathy Bailey, vice president of Aggies for Life, said students have the chance to see that a variety of people have chosen to stand to support the unborn children.

"There are different people who don't fit the mold," Bailey said. Lauren Donahue, director of the Brazos Valley Coalition for Life said Foster will emphasize basic injustice the pro-life movement has caused women.

Donahue said abortion is a choice and a necessary one for some women. Hines said abortion is an easy decision, and many women decide it is not the best option.

Donahue said the original members of the feminist movement were childbearing, while some women today are not. "It's important for students to be beginning to solidify their beliefs to hear Mrs. Foster's strong statement to American women."

24 students arrested following MSU riot EAST LANSING, Mich. (AP) - The broken glass was scattered and the burnt cars were all over Sunday as Michigan State University and East Lansing police battled a riot. At least 24 students were arrested following a riot that broke out in the downtown area and 24 people arrested - some were reviewing videotape to see if they were arrested.

Of the 24 students arrested Sunday, 11 were Michigan State students, East Lansing police said. Michigan State basketball coach Tom Izzo had planned to send his team back to Lansing on Sunday. But the plane had mechanical problems and Izzo said the rampage occurred after the Spartans' appearance in the Final Four.

"These students would be rioting if our debate team lost to the Final Four," said Denbow, Michigan State president of university relations.
