It has been a long time coming, but the N.W.A. family has finally been reunited on CD. Actually it's two CDs.
Although this compilation has 26 songs, only three are actually performed by N.W.A., the pioneering gangsta rap group straight outta Compton.
The rest are performed by the N.W.A. legacy — members of the group and performers closely associated with the band.
This CD has cuts from a wide variety of artists including Eazy-E, Ice Cube, MC Ren, Dr. Dre, Tupac Shakur and Snoop Dogg. Basically, this is a CD of West Coast performers.
This album has remixes of popular hip-hop songs such as "Boyz-N-Tha Hood," "It Was a Good Day" and "Murder Was The Case." Some newer songs from many of the artists are also included.
This album has great sentimental value for anybody who grew up listening to these artists and will provide hours of musical entertainment while remembering the good old days of middle and high school. (Grade: B)

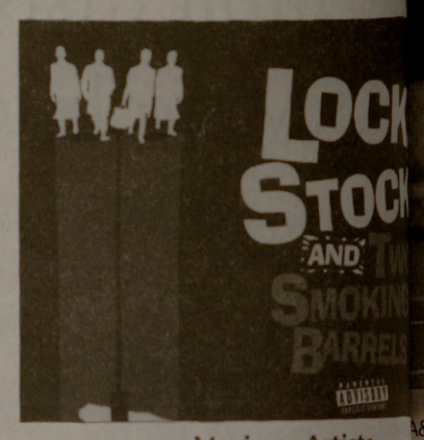

Citizen King

Citizen King, a five-man band from Wisconsin, mixes a variety of synthesizers and samples with a rock 'n' roll attitude on their new CD, *Mobile Estates*.
Much like Beck's *Odelay*, Citizen King successfully mixes melodies with heavy doses of sampling. On tracks such as "Jalopy Style" and "Billhilly," the result is a song that leaves the listener grooving and jumping along with the music. However, in several places on the album, Citizen King abuses the mixing that makes their music so unpredictable and enjoyable. In songs such as "Safety Pin," too much sampling drowns out the band's original and often funny lyrics and bogs the album down.
Perhaps the best aspect of *Mobile Estates* is the band's attitude. Citizen King refuses to take themselves too seriously, adding a lighter tone to their music. On *Mobile Estates*, Citizen King sounds like they enjoy their music rather than simply banging it out — an uncommon commodity for many bands these days. (Grade: B)

The British hit film *Lock, Stock and Two Smoking Barrels* is a hilarious comedy soundtrack complements the movie and adds to the pulp smoothness of the dependent film.
The soundtrack contains older jazz tunes, including "The Boss" and "The Back" by James Brown and "Spooky" by Dusty Springfield, but also uses modern techno-jazz tracks like "Walk This Way" by E-Z Rollers. Punk, jazz, blues, funk, pop and techno songs are all present in a few of the tracks mixing these elements together.
The result is a great soundtrack that adds to the pulp coolness of the movie's characters, like the soundtracks of *Fiction* and *Out of Sight*.
The tracks all contain different styles of music, but each contributes to the overall feel of the film, conveying the ideas of the criminals of the film. The album is as enjoyable and independent as the movie and definitely one to check out. (Grade: B)
